



Hal Hobe Marching Band Scholarship Application

Lakota East High School Marching Band families seeking Marching Band fee assistance are encouraged to apply for Hal Hobe Marching Band Scholarship consideration. The Lakota East Upbeat Club, the band booster organization, reserves fundraising and donation money to finance this scholarship fund for qualifying marching band members entering grades 9-12.

The Hal Hobe Marching Band Scholarship will satisfy half of the Lakota District Participation Fee for Marching Band. Marching Band deposit and trip fees are not included in this scholarship.

Marching band families applying for a Hal Hobe Marching Band Scholarship(s) should:

- Complete the Hal Hobe Marching Band Scholarship Application and Letter Stating Need
- Only ONE application is needed for families applying for 2 or more Marching Band members

The Hal Hobe Marching Band Scholarship Selection Committee will review the applications. Only the LEUC President and Treasurer will know the names of applicants and all information will be kept confidential.

Recipients of the scholarship will be notified before the annual Marching Band Registration meeting. It is the responsibility of the recipient's family to submit the Marching Band deposit due at the Marching Band Registration Meeting and follow the payment schedule outlined by the directors. The LEUC Treasurer will submit full payment of the scholarship award directly to the Lakota East High School Bursar in early June.

To honor Harold "Hal" Hobe's dedication and volunteer work for Lakota Local Schools and the Lakota Band program, the Lakota East Upbeat Club established the Hal Hobe Marching Band Scholarship. Qualified band members benefit from this scholarship, which offers financial assistance with marching band fees.

Mr. Hobe was the founding president of the Lakota East Upbeat Club and the 1996 Barb Bossu Lakota High School Volunteer Spirit Award winner.

Mr. Hobe served as Lakota Upbeat Club President for many years. During his tenure, the Lakota population grew rapidly and this growth required building two new high schools, Lakota East and Lakota West. Mr. Hobe provided significant assistance during this transition time, even coordinating pre-season marching band camp for both the new East and West band programs. The Lakota East Upbeat Club is proud to recognize Mr. Hobe with this namesake scholarship.
